The Disabled Sailing Association of Alberta & Glenmore Sailing Club are proud to announce Steven Fletcher – MP for Charleswood-St James-Assiniboia in Winnipeg – has been appointed Honourary Chair of Mobility Cup 2005.

Steven competed last August in Mobility Cup 2004 in Ninette, Manitoba and, before becoming paralyzed in an auto collision with a moose in northern Manitoba in 1996, Steven was an outdoor enthusiast and Manitoba Provincial kayak champion. Steven has competed at the national level including kayaking in the Canada Summer Games.

In June 2004, Steven defeated Liberal star candidate Winnipeg Mayor Glenn Murray to become the first quadriplegic elected to the House of Commons. Steven serves as Opposition Health Critic for the Conservative Party.

Mobility Cup 2005 has become Canada's international regatta for sailors with disabilities. This event includes participants from across Canada, the United States, the UK, Australia and Japan.

Mobility Cup 2005 – recognised as one of Alberta's 2005 centennial events – takes place Aug 22nd –27th at Glenmore Reservoir in Calgary.
