



Subj: **Potential Damage and Liability to Boats**

To: All participating DSA's in the Harding Medical Mobility Cup 2007

It is the decision of the Mobility Cup 2007 Executive to deal with any potential damage to boats participating in this year's event in the following manner:

1. Both sailors involved in any collision causing damage will forfeit their \$200 damage deposit.
2. Mobility Cup will contribute \$100 to meet the \$500 insurance deductible. If the deductible is \$1000, Mobility Cup will contribute 20% towards the deductible.
3. Mobility Cup 2007 anticipates being able to provide on-site fibreglass repair (working towards a donated service) for immediate repairs when feasible. The goal is to have a local marine fibreglass company "on call" for emergency repairs.

Mobility Cup 2007 does not expect all participants to pay for any damages to boats incurred while competing. If there are any boats or DSA's that do not carry accident insurance or are unwilling to use their insurance they may wish to reconsider entering their boats. Mobility Cup 2007 certainly hopes that is not the case and that the active participation shown over the past events is demonstrated once again.
